The most recent increase was primarily due to increased production cost with only a small increase in postage. The mailing of the February issue cost \$163.73 for first-class mailing of 113 newsletters.

The Activities Director wowed us with events planned for the upcoming year, and ideas for future events were discussed.

We have 262 paid members, up from 259. Testing is still in progress. Joe is all excited about the Culture Quest to be held on April 28th. There was a motion to provide new proctors with a Mensa-branded shirt for positive image projection and identity at testing events. The motion was seconded and passed by unanimous vote.

After all that voting and exhausting work, the meeting was adjourned, with the next meeting at Marker 20 on April 14th.
